# **Chang Group Postgraduate Scholarship**



#### What it offers:

This scholarship covers the tuition for an ethnic minority student who is starting a **Taught Postgraduate Course/Master's Degree** (Full Time/Part Time) at a tertiary institute in Hong Kong. Further, the scholar will be provided **HK\$ 30,000**/- as annual stipend and mentoring by the sponsor for duration of the postgraduate course.

#### **Application is OPEN for:**

- 1. Those who have <u>RECEIVED AN OFFER LETTER</u> for their postgraduate study course starting in academic year 2022-2023 in Hong Kong
- 2. Those who are <u>WAITING FOR THE RESULT</u> of their application for their postgraduate study course starting in academic year 2022-2023 in Hong Kong

**Preference**: The form is OPEN to all applicants. Preference will be given to students who are committed to supporting the development of their communities, including taught master's degrees in disciplines such as social-work, counselling, clinical psychology, healthcare and nursing, psychiatry, technology related or similar fields.

**Gender**: Male or Female

### What will the scholarship cover?

- Full tuition fees for the duration (Full time or Part Time) of the scholar's postgraduate Study. The tuition amount will be paid directly to the university.
- Receive HK\$ 30,000/- annual stipend for the duration of the course.
- The tuition & expenses payment for the next academic year is contingent upon the scholarship recipient satisfactorily meeting his/her responsibilities (see below 'What are the responsibilities of the recipient?').
- Meet up with the sponsor 2 times a year includes mentoring.

#### What are the responsibilities of the recipient?

- Submit academic grades each semester to The Zubin Foundation (TZF) no more than 1 week after its receipt by the recipient.
- Yearly letter of what has most shaped you over the past academic year, by 30th June of each academic year.

- Undertake 20 hours of Community Service with any Hong Kong NGO every year and obtain a letter from the CEO/ED/Social worker of that organisation to that effect.
- Commitment to attend and participate in sponsor's and TZF's networking events (maximum 2 events per year).
- Spend at least 3 weeks over summer doing an internship (optional).
- Complete a well-being check-up organised by TZF.

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Any Hong Kong ethnic minority male or female
- · A resident of Hong Kong with a valid HK ID card
- Must have applied for Postgraduate Study for Year 1 admission in 2022-2023 in an accredited Hong Kong educational institute.
- Must be a Year 1 student in the academic year 2022-2023 for this scholarship
- Should not be an overseas student or student holding study, travel, or visit visa
- Must have demonstrated commitment to community service

### **Scoring of Applications:**

All the valid applications will be evaluated on financial need, graduate academic scores, short essay and Interviews with the sponsors.
